APPLICATION NOTES

Application requirements vary by program. Please double check all requirements with the appropriate program at the Faculty of Nursing as well as with the Chiang Mai University International College or Graduate School.

Transcripts

Official academic records or transcripts which include grades for all degrees earned or courses taken are required. This includes courses and degrees earned from all colleges, universities, graduate or professional schools attended.

Letters of Recommendation

To ensure the privacy and authenticity of the letter, letters of recommendation must be sent directly to Chiang Mai University at the address indicated for each program. If the letter of recommendation is sent to you, do not open it. It will need to be mailed to Chiang Mai University and must arrive in a sealed envelope, signed across the seal by the person writing the recommendation.

English Proficiency Exams

The Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) is required for all participants for whom English is not their primary language and/or studied at an institution where English was not the language of instruction.

Outstanding applicants who do not meet the English proficiency qualifications, may be admitted on a case by case basis, but will be required to enroll in an English course at Chiang Mai University prior to enrollment in the program.

Payment of Application and Other Fees

All required fees must be received in full. You are responsible for paying any transfer or service fees associated with sending payment to Chiang Mai University. Applications with incomplete

payment will not be reviewed. Ensure that your application is reviewed as quickly as possible by sending full payment!

Admissions Decisions

Once all of the required materials are received, your application will be sent to the appropriate admissions review committee. The time it takes for your application to be reviewed varies by the department and program. Once a decision has been made regarding your application, you will be notified.
